Re: RoadQuake 2F Temporary Portable Rumble Strips

Dear Mr. Gray,

Our company recently completed a highway construction project for which we used RoadQuake 2F Temporary Portable Rumble Strips as a means of alerting and calming approaching traffic as they entered the work zone.

This particular project consisted of the portable rumble strips being used in both a four-lane divided segment and a two-lane segment. In the four-lane divided segment, the traffic approached the left/right lane closures at 60+ MPH, and the portable rumble strips performed well in terms of alerting the travelling public to slow down as they entered the work zone lane closure. In the two-lane segment, the portable rumble strips were used in advance of our flagging operation, and the devices worked nicely to gain the attention of drivers as they approached our flaggers.

We continue to seek out any means and methods that can improve our work zone safety. When used in the proper setting (i.e. roadways with wide, safe shoulders to load/unload the devices), portable rumble strips have shown to improve overall work zone safety for our employees and the travelling public.
